THE IMPERATIVE

- The imperative is used to give commands, instructions, requests, or prohibitions.
- The imperative is usually formed with the base form of the verb (without 'to') and is used to address one or more people.

form	explanation	example
positive	the base form of the verb	Plant more trees! Save energy!
negative	don't + base verb	Don't waste water! Don't use plastic bags!
polite form	add please	Please protect our forests. Please turn off the lights.
with object	add object after the verb	Turn off the tap. Use public transport.
with adverb	add an adverb for detail	Shop responsibly. Think globally!
