Please note that there is no elevator at the venue.

ATM

Finland is mostly cashless, but if you need cash, the market square and department stores in the city center have multiple ATMs. The closest ATM to the conference venue is located at Kiinanmyllynkatu 3.

AV EQUIPMENT

The conference rooms are equipped with computers (PC) and audiovisual equipment. We would ask all speakers to bring their presentations with them on a USB memory stick. A conference assistant will be on hand in each room and will upload the presentations to the desktop PC.

We kindly ask you to use a microphone during your presentation. Although you may have a strong voice, using a microphone improves the accessibility of your presentation, especially for participants with potential hearing impairment.

BUS PASS

All conference participants will receive a free bus pass by way of a personal QR-code, sent by email during the last week of May. The email will be titled "IMPORTANT NAAS INFORMATION, PLEASE SAVE." Please save and/or print the email and/or the JPG file containing the code.

The bus pass will be valid from June 3 until June 7, and you may ride the bus as many times as you wish during that period. Please scan the code on entering the bus every time you board. ENTRANCE EXAMS ON CAMPUS

Please note that the conference will take place concurrently with the university's entrance examinations, so the campus will be busy with bustling students.

FEEL-GOOD WORKOUT

On Wednesday and Friday mornings, all conference participants are welcome to join a "feel-good morning flow" light workout to start the day. This involves light movement and tension-releasing exercises and will not necessitate the changing of clothes or any additional gear. The workouts will take place outdoors, on the green area in front of the Publicum building. In case of bad weather, we'll meet in the lobby of the adjacent Educarium building. The workouts will be scheduled as follows: 8:15-8:45 on Wednesday and 8:45-9:15 on Friday.

LUNCH

Lunch will be served on each conference day at the Macciavelli Restaurant in the Educarium building, located right next to the conference venue as follows: 13:00 on Wednesday and Thursday and at 12:45 on Friday. Please note that lunch will be provided only for participants who selected this option during registration.

PHARMACY

If you need a pharmacy (apteekki), the best options will be in the city centre around the market square, including the Sokos Hotel Wiklund, which houses one. The one closest to the conference venue is Nummenmäen Apteekki, located a 12-minute walk away from the campus at Hämeentie 24.

TAXI

If you need to use a taxi in Turku, we recommend booking through Taxi Data, a reliable local provider, tel. **+358 200 10041**. There are also ride-hailing apps, such as Uber and Bolt, available. We do not recommend hailing taxis other than Taxi Data directly on the street, as pricing and quality can vary substantially.

WALKING TO CAMPUS

On the first day of the conference, there will be conference assistants leading participants from the city center to the conference venue. The meeting point is in front of the Sokos Hotel Wiklund, Eerikinkatu 11 (see photo below) at 7:45 AM.







WATER

Please note that it is safe to drink tap water in Finland. We encourage all participants to bring their own refillable water bottles, but it is not required. Complementary water will be available for speakers in each room.
