



Call for abstracts

We invite all interested researchers and clinicians to submit an abstract for the 10th SCENE Symposium on May 10-11, 2024 in Uppsala, Sweden. We call for abstracts with original research and quality improvement projects (QI) related to improving parent-infant closeness. We are particularly interested in the following key themes of the symposium:

“How to support staff to support parents”, “Interventions with a focus on supporting parenting and/or parents’ presence in neonatal intensive care units”, and “Home care”

However, other research, QI projects, and interventions related to parent-infant closeness in neonatal care in general may also be of interest. Accepted abstracts will be presented as oral or poster presentations.

Instructions for submitting abstracts:

The word limit is 300 - including the title, excluding authors’ names and institutions. Abstracts should include the following headings: Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results, and Conclusions. The abstract will be submitted as a pdf attachment to the email. Please indicate if you have any preferences regarding the type of presentation.

The email will be sent to Bente Silnes Tandberg (bstandb@vestreviken.no) by February 29th. Notification of abstract decision (accept/reject) and type of presentation will be emailed to the contact author after March 29th, 2024.
